

Ettore's son, Jean was working on this car when he was killed at the age of 32. The chassis was complete, but not the body. It was completed by Peter Mullin's from drawings by Jean. It is an all aluminum body.

This is a Delahaye. The last time it sold, several years ago, it sold for \$30,000,000. That's 30 million dollars! Our docent said even though it is beautiful, it's hard to drive!
